


ORDINANCE NO. 128 (Amendment to Ordinance No. 124)

So ordained and resolved this \_\_\_\_\_ day of November, 2000, by the Town of Vernon, Indiana by its duly elected Town Council as follows upon a motion duly made and seconded:

- 1.) By a motion duly made and seconded, the council voted unanimously (3-0) to Consider this ordinance on first reading.
- 2.) The following streets in the Town of Vernon, Indiana are hereby declared to Be one-way:
  - a.) North on Jackson Street from State Highway 3 and 7 to Brown Street;
  - b.) East on Brown Street from Jackson Street to the corner of Brown Street and Perry Street;
  - c.) East on Brown Street from the corner of Brown Street and Perry Street to the corner of Brown Street and Posey Street; and,
  - d.) South on Perry Street from the corner of Brown Street and Perry Street to Highway 3 and 7.
- 3.) This ordinance is necessary to promote safety, efficient parking and the flow of efficient traffic in the Town of Vernon.
- 4.) The streets shall be clearly marked and signs clearly posted showing the one-way streets.
