

ORDINANCE NO. 17

Nuisances

Any person who commits any of the following acts within the corporate limits of the Town of Vernon shall be deemed guilty of committing a nuisance, namely: making any loud and unnecessary noise; playing any game on the streets, sidewalk or public square; hitting, aiming or shooting any animal with any missile or other dangerous instrument except in self defense or by lawful authority; disturbing any public meeting or religious gathering; keeping any privy, sewer or septic tank in a foul and noxious condition; obstructing any sidewalk, street or alley; permitting any filth, rubbish or other matter detrimental to the health and comfort of the citizens of the Town to accumulate upon or remain upon his premises; permit any stagnant pond of water to stand on his premises more than three days after he is notified of the same by the Town Marshal; indulging in profane or obscene language; placing any rubbish, ashes, or other noxious substance on any street, alley or sidewalk of the Town; keeping or permitting any filth or object on his premises that emits an unpleasant odor; keeping any barking dog or other animal which disturbs the peace in any manner.

Any person committing any of the above acts shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor and shall on conviction thereof be fined in any sum not less than \$1.00 nor more than \$100.00.
