

Ordinance No. 180

AN ORDINANCE, AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 22, ORDINANCE NO. 68, ORDINANCE NO. 71, ORDINANCE NO. 135, ORDINANCE NO. 155, ORDINANCE NO. 162, REGULATING THE PARKING OF VEHICLES IN THE TOWN OF VERNON

Be it ordained by the Town Council of the Town of Vernon from and after the enactment of this ordinance:

Section I. All ordinances and parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

Section II. As used in this ordinance the following words shall be defined as follows:

- a) "Vehicle" - Every device in, upon, or by which any person or property is or may be transported or drawn upon a highway, except devices moved by human power, used exclusively upon stationary rails or tracks.
- b) "Parking" - The standing of a vehicle upon a street whether such vehicle is occupied or not and whether such vehicle be accompanied or not by an operator.
- c) "Individual Parking Space" - A portion of the paved surface of the street of sufficient length and depth from the sidewalk curb to accommodate a vehicle to be parked, as shall be specified and marked off by direction of the Town Council of the Town of Vernon.

Section III. The Town Council of the Town of Vernon is hereby authorized and directed to designate and mark off individual parking spaces as it deems proper along the streets in the Town of Vernon. At each place where individual parking spaces are marked off, each vehicle shall be parked entirely within an individual parking space. Notice to the public shall be given by appropriate signs or painted markings setting forth the length of time for which parking is permitted and the conditions thereof.

Section IV. Parking shall be prohibited in any alleyway or on any sidewalk in the Town of Vernon.

Section V. Parking shall be prohibited on the south side of Brown Street running 116 feet east from the intersection of Poplar Street and Brown Street.

Section VI. Parking shall be prohibited on Gaines Street between Montgomery Street and Pike Street.

Section VII. It shall be unlawful for any person to park any motor vehicle in the Town of Vernon on of Brown Street between Poplar Street and Pike Street except in a manner parallel to the curb in individual parking spaces as indicated by marked lines painted on the pavement.

Section VIII. It shall be unlawful for any person to park any motor vehicle in the Town of Vernon on the northside of Brown Street between Pike Street and Posey Street except in a diagonal manner in individual parking spaces as indicated by marked lines painted on the pavement.

Section IX. It shall be unlawful for any person to park any motor vehicle in the Town of Vernon on the southside of Brown Street between Pike Street and Perry Street except in a manner parallel to the curb in individual parking spaces as indicated by marked lines painted on the pavement.

Section X. It shall be unlawful for any person to park any motor vehicle in the Town of Vernon on Pike Street between Brown Street and Jackson Street except in a diagonal manner in individual parking

spaces as indicated by marked lines painted on the pavement of Pike Street.


Section XI. It shall be unlawful for any person to park any motor vehicle in the Town of Vernon on the westside of Perry Street between Brown Street and Jackson Street except in a diagonal manner in individual parking spaces as indicated by marked lines painted on the pavement.

Section XII. It shall be unlawful for any person to park any motor vehicle in the Town of Vernon on the eastside of Perry Street between Brown Street and Jackson Street except in a manner parallel to the curb in individual parking spaces as indicated by marked lines painted on the pavement.

Section XIII. Parking of vehicles on the westside of Pike Street between Brown Street and Jackson Street shall last no more than two hours from 7:00 AM until 5:00 PM Monday through Friday in the Town of Vernon.

Section XIV. Any person who violates any provision this ordinance shall be notified of such violation by a written notice affixed by the Town Marshal to the vehicle illegally parked. The Town Marshall shall also have the authority to grant warnings to any person in violation of this ordinance.




