

ORDINANCE NO. 19

Building Permit Ordinance

No person shall erect or cause to be erected any structure, garage, dwelling house or other building upon any property within the Town of Vernon unless he has first filed an application in writing with the Mayor of the Town, which application shall set forth type of construction proposed, the proposed use of such construction, its dimensions and location. Work on such project shall not proceed until a majority of the Town Council has approved the application and such approval shall be acknowledged by a building permit issued by the Town Clerk over the signatures of such members of the Town Council as approve the project.

Any person who violates the provisions of this ordinance shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor and on conviction thereof shall be fined in any sum not less than \$1.00 nor more than \$100.00. Each day during which any structure is permitted to remain in violation of this ordinance shall be considered a separate offense.
