

ORDINANCE NUMBER 39

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING A CURFEW FOR THE TOWN OF VERNON, INDIANA.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Town Council of the Town of Vernon, Indiana, that from and after the enactment of this ordinance and the effective date thereof:

Section 1: It shall be unlawful for any person under the age of 16 years to be present on the public streets, alleys or other public places within the limits of the Town of Vernon, Indiana, between the hours of 9:30 P.M. Central Standard Time, and 6:00 A.M. Central Standard Time unless accompanied by one parent, a natural guardian who is an adult, or unless accompanied by a responsible adult person to whom the custody of the minor has been entrusted by an authorized parent or guardian.

Section 2: Any minor person who violates the provisions of this ordinance shall be taken into custody by the Town Marshall of the Town of Vernon and either turned over to the parent or natural guardian of the minor or taken to the county jail and entrusted to the custody of the Sheriff until such time as the parent or natural guardian of the minor assumes responsibility for him or her.

Section 3: It shall be unlawful for the parent, natural guardian or any other person having the custody of a minor under the age of 16 years to permit such minor to violate this ordinance.

Section 4: Any parent, natural guardian or other person having the custody of the minor who knowingly permits a violation of this ordinance ~~and~~ countenances the same shall be guilty of a misdemeanor and on conviction thereof shall be fined in any sum not less than \$10.00 nor more than \$25.00, and each offense shall constitute a separate violation.
