

ORDINANCE NO. 47

AN ORDINANCE REGULATING THE PARKING AND REMOVAL  
OF UNLICENSED MOTOR VEHICLES ON THE PUBLIC STREETS  
IN THE TOWN OF VERNON.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF VERNON FROM AND AFTER THE ENACTMENT OF THIS ORDINANCE:

SECTION I:

It shall be unlawful for any person to permit any unlicensed motor vehicles to remain on any public streets or place or alley in the Town of Vernon, Indiana.

SECTION II:

An unlicensed vehicle under this ordinance shall be any motor vehicle which fails to display in a prominent place a current valid license plate.

SECTION III:

Any unlicensed motor vehicle left on the public streets, alleys or other public place in the Town of Vernon for a period of twenty-four (24) hours or more shall be considered abandoned and the motor vehicle shall be removed by the Town of Vernon at the expense of the owner of the motor vehicle if the owner can be ascertained.

SECTION IV:

Any person who violates the provisions of this Ordinance shall be notified of such violation by a written notice to be signed by the Clerk-Treasurer of the Town of Vernon, and either personally delivered to the offending property owner by the Town Marshall or by certified mail addressed to the last and usual place of residence of the property owner.

SECTION V:

Any person who, having received such notice, fails to repair or correct the condition constituting a violation of this Ordinance within forty-eight (48) hours after receipt of such notice shall be subject to a civil penalty of not less than \$50.00 nor more than \$250.00.
