ORDINANCE NO. 60

AN ORDINANCE CONSENTING TO THE ISSUANCE OF LIQUOR RETAIL PERMITS IN RESPECT TO PREMISES LOCATED WITHIN THE TOWN OF VERNON

Be it ordained by the Town Council of the Town of Vernon from and after the enactment of this ordinance:

SECTION I

The Town Council of the Town of Vernon hereby consents to the issuance of Liquor Retail Permits by the Indiana Alcoholic Beverage Commission to applicants in respect to premises located within the town limits of the Town of Vernon.

SECTION II

This enabling ordinance may not be altered, amended, or replaced for a period of two (2) years and sixty (60) days after the date of its enactment, and during the period of two (2) years and sixty (60) days from the enactment of this order, no other ordinance on this subject may be enacted.

SECTION III

A copy of this ordinance shall immediately, upon its enactment, be certified by the Clerk-Treasurer of the Town of Vernon and mailed to the Alcoholic Beverage Commission of Indiana by registered mail.

SECTION IV

This ordinance shall be considered in full force and effect immediately after its enactment.
