O.A.S.I. ORDINANCE OR RESOLUTION NO.2

A RESOLUTION electing coverage of the employees of a Political Subdivision of the STATE OF INDIANA as provided by Chapter 313, Acts of 1951, as amended, and as they may be amended, and as they may be implemented by regulations of the State Agency.

PREAMBLE, WHEREAS, Pursuant to action taken by this Governing Body a preliminary survey was made by the State Agency of the O.A.S.I. which State Agency has reported that the estimated employer's cost of coverage in the Old-Age and Survivors' Insurance program will be 6.65 per cent of TOTAL COVERED SALARY AND WAGES TO BE PAID FOR THE YEAR 19 81 plus approximately \$15 Annual Administration Costs.

SECTION 1. THEREFORE, be it resolved, that the Governing Body of TOWN OF VERNON, INDIANA, hereby elects coverage under the OLD-AGE & SURVIVORS' INSURANCE as provided by Chapter 313, Acts of 1951, as amended, and as they may be implemented by regulations of the State Agency.

SECTION 2. The following positions are hereby designated as those which are to be covered. All positions except: (here insert optional exclusions desired and adopted by the Governing Body)\*\* Part-time positions, (normally requiring 600 hours per year or less) Positions, the compensation for which is on a fee basis  
Elected legislative officials      Elected executive officials      Elected judicial officials

SECTION 3. For the purpose of carrying out the provisions of Title II, Section 218, of the Federal Social Security Act and amendments thereof, the agreement entered into between the State Agency with the approval of the Governor and the Social Security Administrator is made a part of this Resolution and shall constitute an integral part of the Federal agreement between this Political Subdivision and the State Agency and shall become a part of the agreement or modification of the agreement between the State and the Social Security Administrator. The Governing Body hereby explicitly agrees that it will fully perform the obligation of a Political Subdivision under said (Federal-State) agreement and Chapter 313, Acts of 1951, as amended and as they may be amended, and as they may be implemented by regulations of the State Agency.

SECTION 4. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect upon passage and approval, for all intents and purposes, except that active coverage shall begin as of the 1st day of January, 19 81.

GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS

In order to obtain O.A.S.I. coverage for the employees of your political subdivision, the resolution on the reverse side must be adopted and spread of record in the minutes of the governing body of your political subdivision.

Coverage must be made effective as of January 1 of the current year or January 1st of the next year. The effective year should be inserted into the "PREAMBLE" and in SECTION 4 of the resolution.

In SECTION 1 of the resolution the legal name of your political subdivision should be entered.

Under SECTION 2 of the resolution the optional exclusions desired by the governing body of your Political Subdivision should be entered. SECTION 2 of the resolution is very important since it defines the scope of coverage that will continue through successive administrations. The only positions which may be excluded from coverage by the governing body of your political subdivision are those listed at the bottom of the resolution form (OPTIONAL EXCLUSIONS). The Social Security Administration does not allow the governing body of your political subdivision to designate which position it wishes to place under coverage; instead, the Social Security Administration sets out certain positions which are the ONLY positions which may be EXCLUDED from coverage at the discretion of your governing body (OPTIONAL EXCLUSIONS). The optional exclusions are the only positions which may be entered under SECTION 2 of the resolution.

In SECTION 4 of the resolution of the Clerk or Secretary should certify that the resolution was adopted and spread of record by the governing body of the political subdivision.

Two certified copies of the resolution should be filed with Public Employees' Retirement Fund-OASI Division, Suite 501 Harrison Building, 143 West Market Street, Indianapolis, Indiana, 46204.

After the Social Security Administration has approved coverage for your political subdivision, your office will be provided with reporting forms with which to file wage reports for the calendar quarters that may have elapsed since the effective date specified in the resolution.
