Above services have been paid by the Town, out of Town funds, \$5,000.00 match funds, and DNR draw down funds of \$150,804.34 received to be used for professional services, and Second DNR Funding in the amount of \$844,784.86 received in mid June to be used for Construction, and local match funds of \$251,000.00 transferred from the County to the Town.

Narrative Section

Progress since last report: On site construction in earnest of sections through the Town by Contractor, and on River section by Volunteer forces. Owner and committee review meetings. Documents uploaded to town website, including daily reports, pay applications, and change orders.

Anticipated work next quarter (next steps):

Month 1: April Construction Phase and Substantial Completion

Month 2: May Punchlist Phase and Final Completion

Month 3: June Document and Funding Closeout

Land Acquisition summary (attach parcel table if necessary): Owner had determined minimum offers. Offers made and accepted for 6 of 7 parcels and closed and recorded. Monies paid for easements paid 100% from other Town funds, not part of the project budget. Town began eminent domain process for final easement in February, formal court filing in March. Initial court hearing set for June moved to mediation in early August. Mediation resulted in increased offer and some plan changes. Revised easement prepared and submitted to Grantor for signature. Signed form returned and separate Notice to Proceed for work on pedestrian bridge issued after easement was recorded in October. This allows continuous access for volunteer forces.

Permitting/Environmental summary: DHPA review complete and comments incorporated. Rule 5 review completed. 4 State Design Releases completed and received. Local building permits in place. DNR CIF review complete, final permit issued July 1, under new state law that does not require property ownership by the Town. Final permits passed on to contractors as they are issued. INDOT application made in January 2024, received final release in November 2024, separate Notice to Proceed issued for that work.

Design/Engineering summary: All work complete except follow up on submittal review.

Obstacles or hardships: One easement parcel of 7 was under court action, revised easement submitted following mediation for signature. Work in this area was bid, but no entry, or notice to proceed was be issued until the court provides the final resolution and recording.

Delay in INDOT permit slowed slow down contractor for work in Right of Way in October and November, and final asphalt placement may not be available until after March 30.

Due to some challenges and changes, Contractor could not be complete by March 30, and requested date change extension for substantial completion from March 30 to April 24, and Final Completion from April 24 to May 23. All work is on track at this time to meet those revised deadlines from Change Order 4.

Potential scope or budget changes: The bid contained accepted alternates in order to meet the budget. A time extension for grant closeout was submitted to DNR and granted as a contract modification. Work items have been addressed in the project allowance, and also three change orders to date to meet existing site modifications and owner requests. Contract amount is currently 1% above awarded bid amount, but all work stands at 3% under overall budget. Due to some site constraints, additional items to meet compliance, drainage and safety are still being required. A final change order 5 is being prepared to cover additions and deductions for the project, but the projection is to remain under budget.

Information needed from DNR or external stakeholders? None at this time. All of local match funds have been drawn down.

Soundbite (How would you describe the <u>current status</u> of the project to local media or elected official in a few sentences?):

Project has continued to stay on track and mostly meet the revised schedule targets as set out 12 months ago.

We have met the schedule for final plans and specs in order to meet Spring 2024 bidding and construction.

Construction began with a slow start, but accelerated in early August, with much work performed, and a large crew on site for paving much of the trail began in late September. Contractor did not have much onsite presence in October or November as they finished other projects and waited on the INDOT permit, but did bring in full time crews to work from December to March. Contractor was shut down from December 20 to January 2. Weather in January and February did not provide for allow for much onsite work. A different crew was brought in March to stay until finished.

Many field changes made to accommodate existing conditions, for safety and drainage, and to meet compliance.

Contractor could not be complete by March 30, and requested date change extension for substantial completion from March 30 to April 24, and Final Completion from April 24 to May 23.

Volunteer forces from the Boy Scout Troops have been working on the River portion of the trail since February, and making good progress on clearing and improvements.

Updates presented and discussed in Town meetings, the project is transparent and available to all on the Town website.

The general public and stakeholders have stated they are glad to see progress and continuing to move forward.

Construction has made a big impact on the Town, and now resident see the vision and the outcome, and are very pleased and looking forward to using the improvements.
